Corporate Volunteering Days

Each year we work with a number of organisations of various sizes who join us for Corporate Volunteer Days. These days are a great way to facilitate team building and improve staff wellbeing whilst supporting your organisation's corporate social responsibility objectives. We can work with you to organise bespoke practical conservation days which suit the needs of your team.

A typical volunteer day

Corporate Volunteer Days generally take place on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Other days may be made available by arrangement.

9am - 10am

Arrive at designated meeting point for task briefing and distribution of tools and equipment.

10.30am - 12.30pm

Volunteer task under Bannau Brycheiniog staff supervision.

12.30pm - 1.30pm

Lunch (not provided), usually outdoors.

1.30pm - 3.30pm

Continue volunteer task.

3pm - 4pm

Departure. Finish times vary depending on the group, activity, and time of year. Latest finish is 4pm in the summer or 3pm in winter.

Please note that this is a rough guide - we may adjust timings and activities to suit the weather conditions, task and need requirements of the group on the day.

To ensure that your day is safe, enjoyable and meaningful, we provide:

- An appropriate volunteer activity, with detailed joining instructions sent out 2-4 weeks in advance.
- A thorough task and safety briefing, followed by ongoing supervision and guidance from knowledgeable and experienced Bannau Brycheiniog staff.
- All personal protective equipment (including work gloves), tools and equipment required for the volunteer activity.
- A comprehensive Risk Assessment.
- Insurance cover via our Public Liability Insurance whilst undertaking the volunteer activity.



What you provide:

- Your own packed lunch, any snacks and drinks required.
- Your own work clothes and footwear, suitable for working outside in all weathers. We will provide specific guidance on what to wear and bring with you on the day.
- Transport to the volunteer site or mutually agreed location.

Pricing

To ensure the sustainability of our work we charge a small fee for the staff time and resources involved in facilitating our bespoke corporate volunteer days. This helps us provide a meaningful volunteering opportunity for your team and supports our work into the future.

Fees include the supervision and guidance of two members of Bannau Brycheiniog staff. Please note there will be a charge of £250 for each additional Bannau Brycheiniog staff member if required.
