



# Natural Bird Feeder



Use natural materials to create a bird feeder to attract birds into your garden.

## What will you need?

- 6 - 8 bendy sticks (Willow, Dogwood or Hazel)
- String and scissors
- Fat ball
- Secateurs

1

Cut 6 - 8 thin, straight Willow, Dogwood or Hazel sticks. These are great because they are bendy.

2

Hold the sticks together. Tie the bottom of the sticks with string.



3

Place the fat ball inside the sticks. Bend the sticks around the fat ball.

4

Hold the top of the sticks together and tie them with string.

5

Make a loop and hang your feeder. Make sure the feeder is above ground to protect your birds from predators.
